Elementary Students

MCDS will, again, be offering our weekly elementary summer camp sessions to children 5½ years through 12 years of age. The first session will begin on Monday, June 18th and the last session will finish on Friday, August 24th. Our staff will be on duty from 7:00 am until 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday, providing interesting and engaging programs for your children. Enrollment is limited to a given number of spaces; you must register to guarantee placement for your child. We will accept registration on a first-come, first-serve basis without regard to race, creed, color or sex.

Sessions will run Monday through Friday as follows:

5 Day Sessions

9:00 am to 12:00 nooncost is \$120.00 (hourly rate \$8.00) per week
(children using 6 or more weeks of this selection will receive a \$5.00 per week discount)

9:00 am to 4:00 pmcost is \$225.00 (hourly rate \$6.43) per week
(children using 6 or more weeks of this selection will receive a \$10.00 per week discount)

Any child choosing to attend less than 5 days per week will be charged a rate of \$12.50 per hour for the session. There will be no credit given for sick days or days not used, as staffing for the sessions must be done in advance. Campers can use before and after program hours from 7:00 to 9:00 AM and from 4:00 to 6:00 PM. Any before and after program hours will be charged at a rate of \$12.50 per hour.

Using the basic format of the Montessori philosophy, each session will feature a theme around which a variety of special games, craft projects and activities will be centered. Outdoor activities (including sprinkler play on Fridays) as well as free play will be included weekly. This group will also be travelling to Berks Lanes to bowl each Monday morning (The cost of this is included in full time campers' tuition; part time campers must pay cash on the day they enroll). A daily snack is included in both the morning and afternoon sessions. Children enrolled in a full day session must pack a lunch and drink; these will be refrigerated. Microwaves are available for use. During the 1:00-4:00 pm time frame, children will choose from classroom materials, special projects and outdoor and indoor free play. This group frequently takes afternoon walks to the Gouglersville Fire Company playground.

Please complete the attached registration form. The cost of one week's session must accompany the registration form to reserve a spot for your child in the summer camp program. Payment for all other weekly sessions must be made on Monday of each week.
